ADVANCED SAFETY AWARENESS COURSE INFORMATION

The **purpose** of the Advanced Safety Awareness Course is to assist students to enhance their safety awareness and decrease risk for injuries. On successful completion, students will achieve an Australian Nationally Recognised Competency.

Students will achieve the **Statement of Attainment** from the Course in Advanced Safety Awareness.

Develop personal safety awareness knowledge and skills. PQ ASA 1

Australian Competency based training is governed by the National VET Regulator (NVR). NVR standards are equal to the best in the world.

Once students have completed their Advanced Safety Awareness Course and achieved their Nationally Recognised Competency they will be eligible to complete an Advanced Safety Awareness (ASA) Safety Assessment.



Achieving a successful standard in the Advanced Safety Awareness Assessment will provide students with an Advanced Safety Awareness Card. The Advanced Safety Awareness Card may be required or accepted by many employers (insurers) and replace the need for repeated safety awareness testing for different organisations or sites.

Confidentiality: Successful completion of the online course competency and/or Advanced Safety Awareness Assessment for training and assessment purposes is the only information recorded at PaQS. All personal details are kept strictly confidential. A PaQS trainer and assessor may contact students to discuss their results.

Requirements:

- Postal addresses are required so training materials, Advanced Safety Awareness Cards and Statements of Attainment can be sent.
- Date of Birth is required so that Statements of Attainment may be issued.
- Email addresses are requested (optional) for notification of completion of the training.

Completion: Upon successful completion of the course competency and Advanced Safety Awareness Assessment students will receive their Statement of Attainment, Advanced Safety Awareness Card and additional training materials designed to advance safety awareness. If the required standard is not achieved on the competency and/or Advanced Safety Awareness Assessment the student will be notified about which elements to review and provided with the opportunity for re-assessment.
